I will be supplying the material, but you will need to bring your own thread. But if you would rather use your materials, you're more than welcome to. I do have a good supply of the dubbing for the "E-Train" since it is my custom blend dubbing.

GRIZ'S "E-TRAIN" EMERGER – BWO VERSION

Tied & Created by Todd A.Schotts / Grizzly Flies by Schottsie

Hook: Sizes 14 & 16 w/2x Gap Nymph/Emerger Hook

(My preference is FireSticks 633 from Fire Hole Outdoors)

Thread: 8/0 or 70 Denier Olive

Tail: Whiting Brahma Hen Mottled Gray/Olive

Body: Custom Dubbing: Hareline Dark Hares Ear, STS Trilobal Olive, and Hareline Ice Dub Peacock (mixture is 1/8, ½, & 1/8 roughly

Ribbing: BR Copper Wire

Collar: SLF Squirrel Spikey Dubbing Gray

Underwing: Gray Polypro Yarn

Wing: Whiting Brahma Hen Saddle Mottled Gray/Olive

GRIZ'S "SWAMP STOMPIN' BWO BEADHEAD

Tied & Created by Todd A.Schotts / Grizzly Flies by Schottsie

Hook: 60 degree Jig Hook – Sizes 16, & 18 **Thread:** 70 Denier or 8/0 Olive & Black

Tail: Blue Dun Hackle Fibers

Bead: Black or Gold Slotted Tungsten Bead

Rib: UTC Copper Wire Small **Body:** Olive or Gray Ostrich Hurl

Collar: Black Arizona or SLF Squirrel Dubbing
