Hook: Size 10 1x fine dry fly Thread: 8/0 Uni Purple Wing: Hi-Vis light gray

Tail: Medium Dun hackle fibers

Abdomen: 3 sections: Opal tinsel, purple

thread, opal tinsel

Parachute Hackle: Medium Dun

Thorax: Purple thread
